## **THE SOCIETY PROVIDES—**

- A Church where members meet weekly for Religious Worship.
  - An Employment Bureau for the placing of members in selected useful and profitable employment.
  - A Staff to assist members in all business transactions, to act as interpreters, and to give advice and encouragement in the many problems of everyday life.
  - Honorary Medical Service and relief in necessitous cases.
  - Club Rooms where members meet for recreation and comradeship so vital to Deaf and Dumb people and a small Nursery for the use of our Deaf mothers.
  - Adult Education Classes for the further education of Deaf members after leaving school.
  - A Recreation Ground containing three Tennis Courts and a modern Club House for the sole use of our Deaf people and their children.
  - The "Edith Bryan Hostel" for our Deaf people without homes and for Deaf visitors from the country districts of Queensland.
